BLOOD DONATION CAMP

This year saw an impressive **111** units of blood donated, highlighting the event's growth and impact.

Process & Preparations:

The planning and preparations for this event started weeks in advance. A dedicated team of volunteers was employed to ensure success. Key preparations included:

Venue Setup: The venue was equipped with comfortable sitting arrangements for both donors and medical team. Adequate lighting, ventilation and uninterrupted power supply were ensured at the donation venue.

Registrations and Health Screening: To begin with, a total of 171 registrations were received. Each donor underwent a health screening to determine eligibility. Donors were briefed about the importance of blood donation and were also provided with a questionnaire to access their health and travel history.

Donation Process: Eligible donors proceeded to the donation area where they were skillfully attended to by the medical team. The blood donation process went smoothly, and donors were monitored for any adverse reactions. Special care was taken for COVID situation.

Refreshments and Appreciations: Post donation, donors were offered refreshments and an appreciation certificate recognizing their selfless act and commitment to saving lives.
