### **Preamble:**

Most of the ordinances of the ICT were passed by BoG in 2005 and 2008. The structure of ICT has undergone changes and new Statutes came into existence in 2014. Many nomenclature (such as Vice Chancellor instead of Director, Academic Council instead of Senate) therefore require changes. The Board of Studies for each program is now always asked for by NAAC, NBA etc and hence has been incorporated in the ordinance.

In addition to the above, the admission committees for UG and PG admissions function separately in the ICT since many years but were not mentioned so in the ordinance.
