Thorat</p> <p>In response to the various complaints raised by faculty members of ICT-IOCB and also by Rasmi Rajan Dora, Media Consultant against Professor B.N. Thorat, the redressal procedure for the same was initiated by appointing the fact-finding committee as follows:</p> <p>Professor P.V. Devarajan – Chair person</p> <p>Dr. Sanjay Kemkar – Member</p> <p>Mr. Pardip Gharat, Advocate – Member</p> <p>Dr. Sanjay Mehendale, President, UAA – Member</p> <p>Professor S.T. Mhaske, Dean Off-Campuses – Member</p> <p>After due hearings and giving ample chances to the complainant as well as Professor Thorat, the fact finding has submitted the report with following recommendations:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Professor B. N. Thorat's conduct was found violating the various codes of conduct applicable to the faculty members of the Institute as per provisions of "The Code of Ethic and Code of Conduct" as prescribed under the Institute Statutes and thus is liable for further disciplinary action. 2. The fact finding committee has also found Professor Thorat guilty of the offence of misappropriation of the Institute funds which were utilised to meet his personal, domestic and other expenses for which he was not entitled to and thus is liable for appropriate action as per statutory provision. <p>In the meanwhile, Professor Thorat has issued two notices to the Institute through his Advocates. The first Notice was issued by Adv. Pradyuman Waghmare, Advocate High court and Notary, Gol vide a letter dated 5th August, 2023 which was duly responded by the Institute by intimating the findings of the Grievance Committee to Professor Thorat vide Institute letter dated 3rd October, 2023. The second notice was issued by Adv. Nitin Satpute and Associates, Advocates of Supreme court of India & Bombay High Court dated 30th October, 2023 which is issued in response to the Institute notice dated 24th September, 2021.</p> <p>The Institute notice dated 24th September, 2021 was issued to Professor Thorat for submitting his say against the various grievances raised by the faculty at ICT-IOCB, which is now (after 2 years) responded by him through his lawyer. This also may be noted that Professor Thorat has participated in the grievance redressal process and at the end of grievance redressal process, when he was intimated the outcome of he being guilty, this notice is after thought with a view to nullify the outcome of Fact Finding Committee.</p>	<p>To discuss an agenda Item 3, Professor A. B. Pandit, Vice Chancellor and Chairman of BOG, requested that the BOG members allow him to go out and select anyone amongst you to chair the meeting for this agenda item.</p> <p>Accordingly, Professor V. G. Gaikar acted as Chairman. (Reason- Professor Pandit being the party against whom the complaint was made).</p> <p>After that, the Vice Chancellor left the meeting for this particular Item only. The Registrar requested Professor R. V. Adivarekar, Dean (HRD), who handles grievances and related matters, to explain all the correspondence and recommendations the fact-finding committee made to all Board members. Professor Adivarekar explained the matter to the BOG members and requested suspension of Professor Thorat followed by detailed enquiry as mentioned above.</p> <p>The matter was discussed at a length and the Board members unanimously resolved as follows:</p> <p>Except point No. 2 all other points are approved by the Board Members.</p> <p>On point No. 2 following action was suggested by the Board Members;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. As prescribed under clause 13.8(1) of statutes detailed inquiry should be initiated against Prof. Thorat to ascertain exact gravity of offences committed by him. 2. As Prof. Thorat is indulging in various tactics to pollute the minds of non-teaching staff and also routinely filing mischievous and baseless complaints at police station, he should be suspended till the completion of detailed inquiry against him. 3. As advised under structural audit report, permission is requested to demolish the building under due permission of BMC.

5. Demolition of Dyes Building

Under the financial assistance through industry donation, a new Dyes building having carpet area 1781.91 sq. mtrs. is already constructed and made functional for the Speciality Chemicals Technology (dyes) Department since August, 2021. The old dyes building along with temporary shades provided to gardener having the carpet area 1387.98 sq. mtrs. is already declared unsafe vide the structural audit report dated 26th June, 2019. The major findings of this structural audit report (Annexure - 2) are as following:

1. Due to moderate and major structural damages the overall conditions of the building is poor.
2. If the building is to be used, it will need major structural repair.

In view of above findings of structural audit report and in consideration of the fact that new building is already constructed for the dyes department, it is proposed to demolish this building along with the auditorium building and the combined land may be used for further infrastructural development as per the availability of the funds.
