### 3. Status of Grievance Redressal against Professor B.N. Thorat

In response to the various complaints raised by faculty members of ICT-IOCB and also by Rasmi Rajan Dora, Media Consultant against Professor B.N. Thorat, the redressal procedure for the same was initiated by appointing the fact-finding committee as follows:

After due hearings and giving ample chances to the complainant as well as Professor Thorat, the fact finding has submitted the report with following recommendations:

- Professor B. N. Thorat's conduct was found violating the various codes of conduct applicable to the faculty members of the Institute as per provisions of "The Code of Ethic and Code of Conduct" as prescribed under the Institute Statutes and thus is liable for further disciplinary action.
- 2. The fact finding committee has also found Professor Thorat guilty of the offence of misappropriation of the Institute funds which were utilised to meet his personal, domestic and other expenses for which he was not entitled to and thus is liable for appropriate action as per statutory provision.

In the meanwhile, Professor Thorat has issued two notices to the Institute through his Advocates. The first Notice was issued by Adv. Pradyuman Waghmare, Advocate High court and Notary, GoI vide a letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2023 which was duly responded by the Institute by intimating the findings of the Grievance Committee to Professor Thorat vide Institute letter dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2023. The second notice was issued by Adv. Nitin Satpute and Associates, Advocates of Supreme court of India & Bombay High Court dated 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 which is issued in response to the Institute notice dated 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2021.

The Institute notice dated 24th September, 2021 was issued to Professor Thorat for submitting his say against the various grievances raised by the faculty at ICT-IOCB, which is now (after 2 years) responded by him through his lawyer. This also may be noted that Professor Thorat has participated in the grievance redressal process and at the end of grievance redressal process, when he was intimated the outcome of he being guilty, this notice is after thought with a view to nullify the outcome of Fact Finding Committee.

To discuss an agenda Item 3, Professor A. B. Pandit, Vice Chancellor and Chairman of BOG, requested that the BOG members allow him to go out and select anyone amongst you to chair the meeting for this agenda item.

Accordingly, Professor V. G. Gaikar acted as Chairman. (Reason– Professor Pandit being the party against whom the complaint was made).

After that. the Vice Chancellor left the meeting for this particular Item only. The Registrar requested Professor R. V. Adivarekar, Dean (HRD), who handles grievances and related matters, to explain all the correspondence and recommendations the factfinding committee made to Board members. Professor Adivarekar explained the matter to the BOG members requested suspension of Professor Thorat followed by detailed enquiry as mentioned above.

The matter was discussed at a length and the Board members unanimously resolved as follows:

Except point No. 2 all other points are approved by the Board Members.

On point No. 2 following action was suggested by the Board Members;

In view of above, facts following action was suggested against Prof. Thorat-

- As prescribed under clause 13.8(1) of statutes detailed inquiry should be initiated against Prof. Thorat to ascertain exact gravity of offences committed by him.
- As Prof. Thorat is indulging in various tactics to pollute the minds of non-teaching staff and also routinely filing mischievous and baseless complaints at police station, he should be suspended till the completion of detailed inquiry against him.
- Shri. Sadashiv Benke, Rtd. Deputy Secretary who is empanelled by Govt. of Maharashtra as Inquiry Officer for conducting Detailed Inquiries may be appointed as Inquiry Officer after taking his due consent.
- 4. Shri Prashant Mayekar, Rtd. Deputy Secretary may be appointed as Institute Presenting Officer.
- Adv. Ashutosh Kulkarni (Institute Lawyer) shall provide legal assistance during the process of Inquiry.
- Presenting Officer shall be provided expert assistance by reputed Charted Account for ascertaining the exact misappropriation of Institute Funds.
- Inquiry Officer and Presenting Officer should be given three months for the completion of Inquiry.

Necessary steps for the completion of proposed inquiry shall be initiated on approval.

- Dr. Jere also suggested to Professor Devarajan (Chairman, Fact Finding Committee) to do the presentations related to this matter (Report by Fact Finding Committee) in the next meeting.
- Shri J.R. Shah also suggested to appoint local Legal lawyer and/or CA from reputed firm.
- Till the departmental enquiry and Audit is completed, Professor Thorat's suspension is kept in abeyence. This should be completed within 3 months of initiating the enquiry.

#### 4. Demolition of New Auditorium (Near GC)

The new auditorium (Near Godrej Canteen) building having carpet area of 864.72 sq. mtrs is a 50 years old building. During preliminary inspection many cracks and dampness were noticed in the ceiling and walls of the building. In view of this a detailed structural audit was carried out and the report of the structural audit of the building is attached as Annexure - 1.

The conclusion of the structural audit report is as following:

- Major to severe structural damage is observed in the building and thus the condition of the building is certified as bad to worst.
- In view of severally distressed and dilapidated condition the building should be demolished adhering to all safety, precaution under expert guidance.

The Board noted the fact and approved the proposed demolition.



As adviced under structural audit report, permission is requested to demolish the building under due permission of BMC. **Demolition of Dyes Building** Board approved the Under the financial assistance through industry donation, a new demolition of said Speciality Dyes building having carpet area 1781.91 sq. mtrs. is already Chemicals Technology constructed and made functional for the Speciality Chemicals (dyes) building.
