

R.18 Provisions at the time of Revision of Syllabus

- 1) Any revision of any syllabus should be brought in force in a gradual manner from the first year of the respective course.
- 2) Three successive chances, in the form of continuous regular and repeat examinations, shall be given, after the respective last regular examination based on the old course, to the students belonging to the old course. If a student fails to clear a subject even after these chances, he/she shall have to take admission as a fresh student for an equivalent course offered in the revised programme.
- 3) After conducting three continuous examinations after the regular examination of the final year, the old course shall be declared as abandoned and no examination for any semester shall be conducted thereafter.
- 4) At the time of syllabus revision, the equivalence between the subjects in the old syllabus and the new syllabus shall be outlined.
- 5) In case the equivalence cannot be established, the student may be permitted to take an equivalent course through MOOC as per the provisions of R.27.
